Jason Henry – HOC Updates

This week Alternative Solutions started at HOC for initial meeting. On June 1st Kevin Warwick will be presenting the commissioners with a progress report. The first week in May is correctional worker appreciation week; there will be a banquet to celebrate on May 26th at 6pm.

Chuck Stuart – Finance Office – Insurance updates

Dental insurance premiums have gone up 24.4%

Health insurance rates with Interlocal Trust are increasing 9.2% and the county is receiving a \$73,000 rebate that will help offset this increase.

Pennichuck Water proposal came in at \$16,200 not to include billing which would cost another \$2,400. There are several other costs that would still be the responsibility of the county. Ken does not see the value and Commissioner Sorensen does not see a benefit to going outside the county for this service.

Commissioner Babson motioned to keep the water system under the control of Carroll County seconded by Commissioner Sorensen: motion passed on 2-1 vote with Commissioner Ahlgren voting "Nay"

Commissioners discussed what to do with the blueberry bushes this year. Options are having PYO blueberries, having inmates pick them and leasing out the bushes.
