Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT)

Robichaud said the State female prisoners have filed a grievance following the commissioners' vote on MAT at the jail and the State of NH will pull its female inmates from CCHOC if MAT is not offered. Robichaud said that Rockingham County has threatened to cancel their Carroll County contract as well.

Comeau noted the lack of communication and conflict between the two "sides" regarding the issue of MAT at CCHOC. He encouraged all to come together, something he will facilitate if necessary, to air concerns and come to agreement.
