MOTION: "To enter into non-public session under NH RSA 91-A:3, II (c), Matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person, other than a member of the public body itself, unless such person requests an open meeting. This exemption shall extend to any application for assistance or tax abatement or waiver of a fee, fine, or other levy, if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant" by Babson, 2nd McCarthy. Passed on a roll call vote 3-0.
