**Current Status:**

Week 5 of recent outbreak.

This cluster of 8 positive tests began on 8/25/2021.

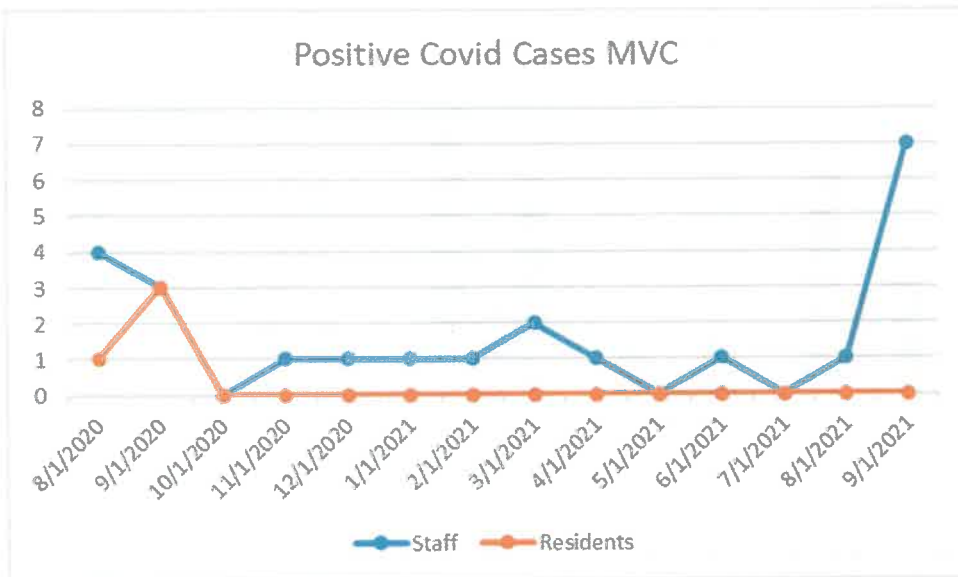
All staff and no residents to date.

Of the 8 positive staff – 5 were vaccinated and 3 were unvaccinated.

Given the community spread numbers, we are testing twice a week until the rates go down. In order to be out of outbreak, we need two weeks of zero positive cases.

We are currently closed to admissions and allowing only compassionate care visits. These are permitted in cases where emotional or mental health would benefit from a visitation. These are done window visits. Other types of visits are permitted such as FaceTime and Skype.

Residents are restricted to their specific unit unless they are taken outside for fresh air daily. Activities are taking place in the units at this time. Only medically urgent appointments are allowed.



**Testing from 9/22/21 (late addition)**

**All residents and staff are negative!!!**

**The fact that we have been fortunate to isolate the positive staff from residents and other staff, and the low overall cases of positive COVID residents, speaks volume to the diligence of the staff in safeguarding our residents. They are to be commended.**

**Communications:**

Every effort is made to keep the families, residents, staff and public informed about the wellbeing of Mountain View Community. This is accomplished by utilizing a family email list to reach out to all our families and residents. A Facebook page is maintained and regularly updated. Communication with news outlets are consistently reaching out for the most recent information on the facility. Staff are meeting with residents on the units to update them on testing and results.

It is understandable that families and residents are frustrated with another round of outbreak and want to visit with family and friends and go out to enjoy the last of summer and early fall. They are concerned and sometimes confused by the news and its relation to mandatory vaccines for nursing home staff. As are we.

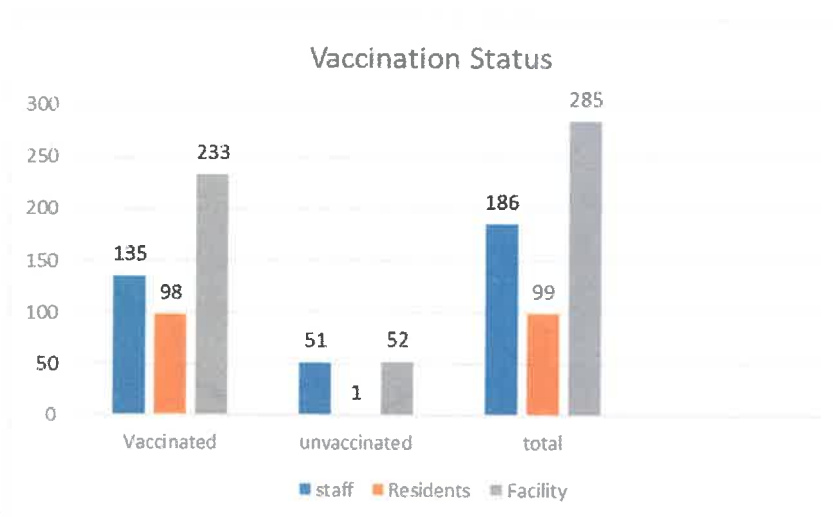
**Staffing:**

We are excited to have 4 newly trained and licensed MNA staff who took our class and passed the exams with flying colors.

We are currently down 9 positions. These are from mostly nursing department.

Staff are asking lots of questions of the looming mandatory vaccination in nursing homes. At this time, we have no information or guidance to offer.

51 of the staff are unvaccinated and this WILL impact the ability of staff to satisfactorily care for our residents and the facility.



**Holiday activities:**

Our craft fair was cancelled for November this year as well as Halloween activities with the children. We are going to do a parade of staff throughout the building in costume and bring kids outside to trick or treat in the outdoor patio areas and out the pictures on our TV for resident to watch.

**Union negotiations:**
