Program 1: Club 121 Individual Mentoring Services

Description: Through this program, KYC staff members will hold weekly individual mentoring sessions with middle school students at Kingswood Regional Middle School. Sessions will focus on goal setting, self-exploration, and academic and social progress and will be offered to students facing challenging circumstances. The program will help mitigate social and academic setbacks incurred as a result of COVID interruptions.

Proposed Use of ARPA Funds (represents 60% of the program budget):

Salaries: 4 hrs. per week X 41 weeks X \$29 per hour (average loaded cost) = \$4,756

per year X3 years = \$14,268

Supplies Cost: \$100 per year X 3 years = \$300

Program 2: KYC Kupboard (food pantry)

Description: Through this program, the families of KYC students will have access to free nutritious fresh, frozen, and shelf-stable foods and other essentials. This program was implemented in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and the KYC seeks to continue this service due to ongoing needs stemming from the pandemic.

Proposed Use of ARPA Funds (represents 25% of the program budget):
